Item or Task	Date Completed
Form and Repeats	
1. I have verified all repeats or other indicators of the music's <i>form</i> (da Capo, DS al Coda, 1 st & 2 nd Endings, etc.) and determined if they are supposed to be observed or ignored.	
2. I have confirmed whether the entire piece is to be performed or if only certain measures are to be played.	
Time Signature & Tempo	
3. I understand the time signature of this piece of music.	
4. I have examined the music for any changes in the time signature.	
5. I understand the target performance tempo of this music.	
6. I have observed all changes in tempo and understand them.	
Musical Terms	
7. I have personally found the definitions to all musical terms and understand how they apply to this music.	
Key	
8. I have examined all key signatures in the music.	
9. I can play through the scales associated with each key signature appearing in the music.	
10. I know the name of each major or minor key appearing in the music.	
11. I have observed the proper key signature throughout all octaves.	
12. I can perform the scales associated with all of the keys represented in my music.	
13. I have identified all accidentals and determined if there are any carry-through-the-measure spots.	
Dynamics	
14. I have observed all dynamic markings. Do the dynamics of the piece change?	
15. I have observed all changes in dynamics and I am prepared to exaggerate them so listeners may perceive the changes.	
Articulation	
16. I have gone through the entire piece articulating every note with a "Tah", "Dah", or "Ah" syllable (or slight variations of these syllables)?	
Phrases & Breathing	
17. I have examined the music for specific phrase markings or implied musical phrases due to rests or note patterns?	
18. I have marked where I will breathe with my pencil.	
Errata	
19. If applicable, I have reviewed an errata sheet and I have made any indicated corrections with my pencil.
